OBJECTIVES

The Franklin Institute Philadelphia's premier science museum needed a more efficient, impactful way to communicate ticketing information, promote upcoming exhibits, and modernize food-service signage. Printed signs were costly, time consuming to update, and limited in visual impact. The goal was to introduce digital signage solutions that streamlined updates, reduced perceived wait times, and enhanced the visitor experience from the moment guests walk through the door.

SOLUTIONS

- Modern Digital Video Walls: Installed a large format video wall at the ticketing entrance to improve communication and capture guest attention immediately
- <u>Custom Display Structures:</u> Built two custom floorstanding monitor ribbon walls one 3×1 at Foodworks Express Café and one 4×1 at the Ff Café using RP Visual custom mounting solutions
- <u>Centralized Digital Signage Software:</u> Implemented Scala digital signage software and hardware for streamlined content creation, scheduling, and deployment
- Ongoing Training & Support: Provided hands-on guidance, training to help the Franklin Institute team manage content and maximize system value
